Through a series of “Conversations on European Security” the Geneva Centre for Security Policy and the Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung have identified several elements that need to be considered. The Peace Matrix outlines the multidimensional nature of the security challenges in the OSCE area and provides an overview of the different pieces involved and how they inter-relate.
